

## How to reach CIEMAT from Moncloa?

The centre is located at the very end of the university campus (Ciudad Universitaria).

Please, note that to access the centre you need to show your ID at the security point where you will be given a guest card and a map of the facilities of the centre.



### BY CAR

- CIEMAT has its own free car parking.
- From Moncloa: Arco de Triunfo, Avda. Arco de la Victoria (A6), Plaza. de Cardenal Cisneros y Avda. Complutense.
- From M-30: exit Sinesio Delgado, direction Ciudad Universitaria-CIEMAT.

### PUBLIC TRANSPORT IN MADRID

#### *By bus*

- Línea 82 - Paraninfo-CIEMAT stop (<https://www.google.es/maps/dir/Moncloa,+Madrid/Ciemat,+Avenida+Complutense,+Madrid/@40.4514135,-3.732308,15z/data=!4m16!4m15!1m5!1m1!1s0xd422843909ee4bf:0x85526d5d68c16536!2m2!1d-3.7178726!2d40.4335077!1m5!1m1!1s0xd422834944ca2a5:0x579956ccb574c51b!2m2!1d-3.7288731!2d40.4541302!2m1!5e0!3e3?hl=es>). This is the best way to get to CIEMAT from Moncloa. The starting point of the bus line is at Meléndez Valdés, 72.

- Lines F (exit from Cuatro Caminos, <https://www.google.es/maps/dir/Cuatro+Camino,+Madrid/Ciemat,+Avenida+Complutense,+Madrid/@40.4458637,-3.7338684,14z/data=!3m1!4b1!4m16!4m15!1m5!1m1!1s0xd4228560b848223:0x1872df6b7757b17d!2m2!1d-3.7039812!2d40.4475891!1m5!1m1!1s0xd422834944ca2a5:0x579956ccb574c51b!2m2!1d-3.7288731!2d40.4541302!2m1!5e0!3e3?hl=es>), G (same trip as by car) and U (exit from Moncloa), all of them stop at Paraninfo-Telecomunicaciones.

*By underground*

- From the Barajas airport, line 8 “Barajas-Aeropuerto” (<https://www.google.es/maps/dir/Aeropuerto+de+Madrid-Barajas,+Madrid/Ciemat,+Avenida+Complutense,+Madrid/@40.4474066,-3.724649,15z/data=!4m16!4m15!1m5!1m1!1s0xd4231d000000001:0x4af76446a748bf62!2m2!1d-3.576197!2d40.477891!1m5!1m1!1s0xd422834944ca2a5:0x579956ccb574c51b!2m2!1d-3.7288731!2d40.4541302!2m1!5e0!3e3?hl=es>). Please, note that there are two different stops: one from terminals T1-2-3 and another for T4. Be sure the terminals T1, T2, T3, and T4 are also connected by shuttle service. For reaching CIEMAT from the airport, use line 8, stop at “Nuevos Ministerios” station to get the line 6 towards “Ciudad Universitaria” station.
- From the “Ciudad Universitaria” metro station, line 6, once reached the Ciudad Universitaria metro station, follow the itinerary attached to reach CIEMAT (<https://www.google.es/maps/dir/40.4435994,-3.726704/Ciemat,+Avenida+Complutense,+Madrid/@40.4464797,-3.7272372,17z/data=!4m11!4m10!1m0!1m5!1m1!1s0xd422834944ca2a5:0x579956ccb574c51b!2m2!1d-3.7288731!2d40.4541302!2m1!5e0!3e2?hl=es>).
